Your Committee needs new members

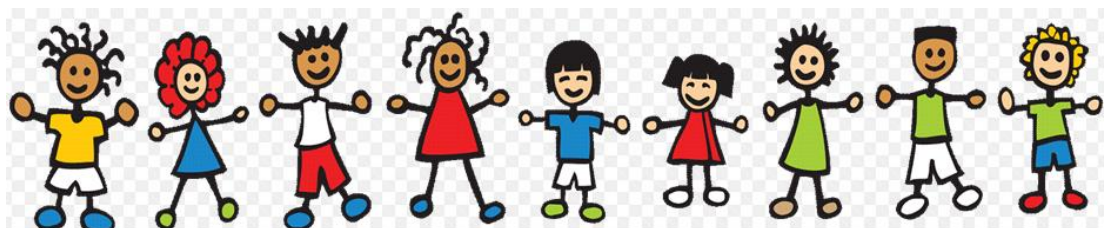
Interested, but not sure what's involved in being on the Committee?
