

A reminder about *Claiming*

During play, if you decide to claim the remaining tricks, you must make a clear statement about the order the cards will be played in, or the line of play or defence you plan to take.

After any claim play ceases, but if it's disputed you must call the Director immediately.

No action should be taken until the Director arrives – i.e. don't gather your cards up to return to the board, or continue playing the cards. The Director will decide what happens next

COVID-19 requirements

Your Committee decided to wait until after next's week's Covid announcement, so at this stage there are no change to the COVID measures which are:

- Mandatory mask wearing for all bridge sessions (unless medical exception)
- Please bring your own pencils/pens
- Please make sure your partner is keen to play and understands these restrictions

As we are not having a tea break in the evening sessions, if you need to have a break please do so when it is your turn to be dummy. Just ask the table for permission and your partner can manage your cards until you return.

Finally, please do not come to bridge if you are feeling unwell. There are still lots of cases of COVID in the community and with the normal winter illnesses, it is better to be cautious.
